We are pleased to announce that all Venango and Crawford County Head Start classes will return to full-time, in-person instruction next month.

Crawford County classrooms (Willow, East End) will return to five days a week beginning on Tuesday, April 6, while Venango County classrooms (7th Street, Grant Street, Cranberry) will do the same starting on Wednesday, April 7.

Transportation routes are being adjusted and will be finalized the week of March 29 through April 2.

Your Family Engagement Specialist, Center Director or another CDC representative will contact you during the week to inform you of your child's transportation details.

All COVID-19 safety precautions, including entry screenings and mask wearing, will remain in effect at all times.

Our learning environment has become even safer recently, as roughly half of CDC's employees have already received a COVID-19 vaccine with more scheduled to do so in the near future.
