

Hybrid Learning Plan – Venango/Crawford Head Start

Child Development Centers, Inc. is pleased to announce that all Venango and Crawford County Head Start classrooms will be transitioning to a hybrid learning model beginning Monday, Feb. 8.

Students will be divided into two separate groups to determine scheduling with the first group having in-person instruction on Mondays and Thursdays, while the second group attends on Tuesdays and Fridays. Teachers will continue to provide remote learning opportunities on the remaining three days each week.

In addition, Head Start food delivery will continue, but will now take place on Wednesdays only. The schedule had varied depending on what center the child attended. If a family chooses to participate in the hybrid model and send their child back to school, they will still be able to receive food.

No changes have been made to transportation arrangements or the bus routes used earlier in the school year.

Our Center Directors, Family Engagement Specialists and teaching staff will be reaching out to families this week to provide details on each child's schedule and answer any questions.

Although this is not a full return to in-person classes, we are excited to bring back the children in a limited capacity.

Health and safety protocols will continue to be a priority and the Health Services Team will closely monitor the COVID-19 situation in our region as the school year plays out.
